

BRAXTON

(Major NPC)

Captain Braxton is a Starfleet officer from the 29th century. He was the CO of both the *U.S.S. Aeon* and the *U.S.S. Relativity*. A victim of several temporal paradoxes and incidents, including devastating ones caused by Janeway, some versions of Braxton have succumbed to temporal psychosis. It is often difficult to predict what version of Braxton has been encountered, or how stable he is.

Stress: 12 **Resistance:** 2 (futuristic uniform that acts as body armor)

Attacks:

- Unarmed Strike (Melee, 5A, Nonlethal, Knockdown, 1H)
- Futuristic Phaser (Ranged, 8A, Charge, Hidden, 1H)

Special Rules

Bold (Security): Whenever Braxton attempts a Security Task and he buys one or more d20s by adding to Threat, he may re-roll a single d20.

Future Tech: Braxton may obtain any number of 29th century equipment at a cost of Opportunity 1 at the start of any Scene. This cost replaces any normal cost. These are later generation technology (page 188). These may include futuristic weapons or time travel technology (like the Temporal Transporter).

Different Versions of Braxton: Braxton may declare that a future or past version of himself is active during the mission starting this Scene, by increasing the Complication Range for the mission by 2, to a maximum of 5. (This normally limits his appearances to 3 versions of himself in a mission.)

That's The Paradox: Once during any Scene, for one Task, Braxton may roll his dice pool twice, taking the dice pool result he prefers. This applies only to his pool, not to dice rolled by Assists. 'That's the Paradox' does not count as a re-roll, so any re-rolls may be applied after he chooses his pool.
