

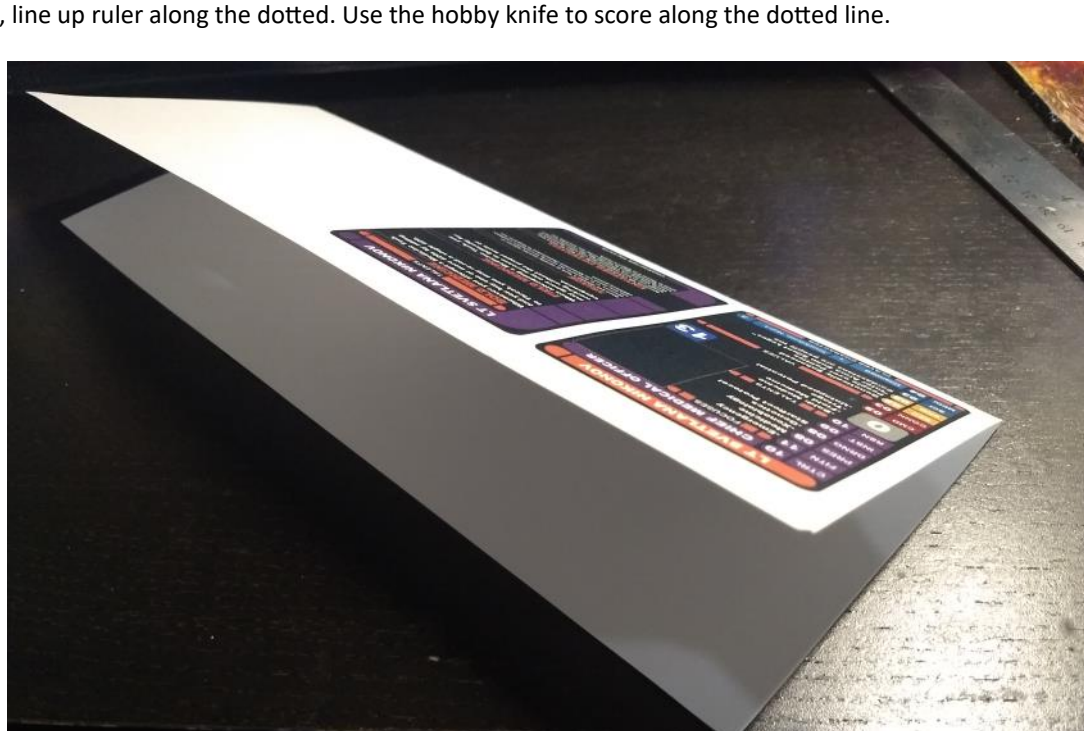


1) Gather supplies

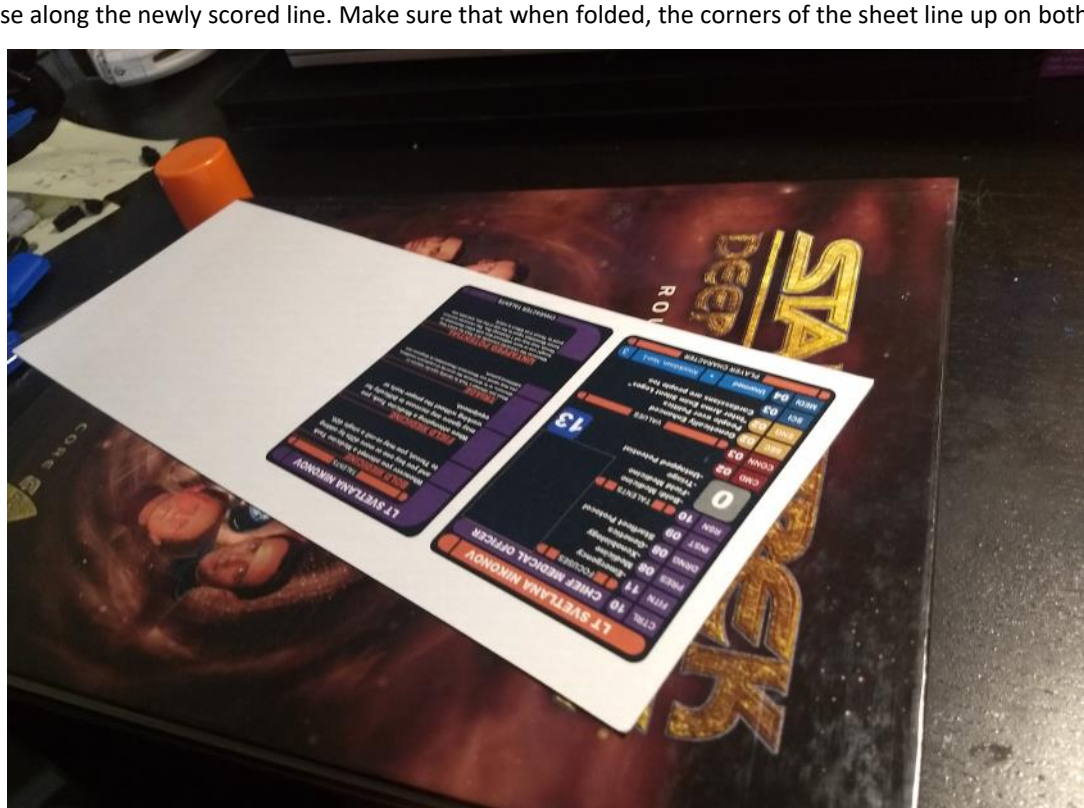
- Sturdy scissors
- Hobby Knife
- Ruler (metal preferred)
- Spray Adhesive (PVA/white glue will also work, but risks warping)
- Corner cutter (not necessary, but looks nice)



2) Lay out sheet, line up ruler along the dotted. Use the hobby knife to score along the dotted line.



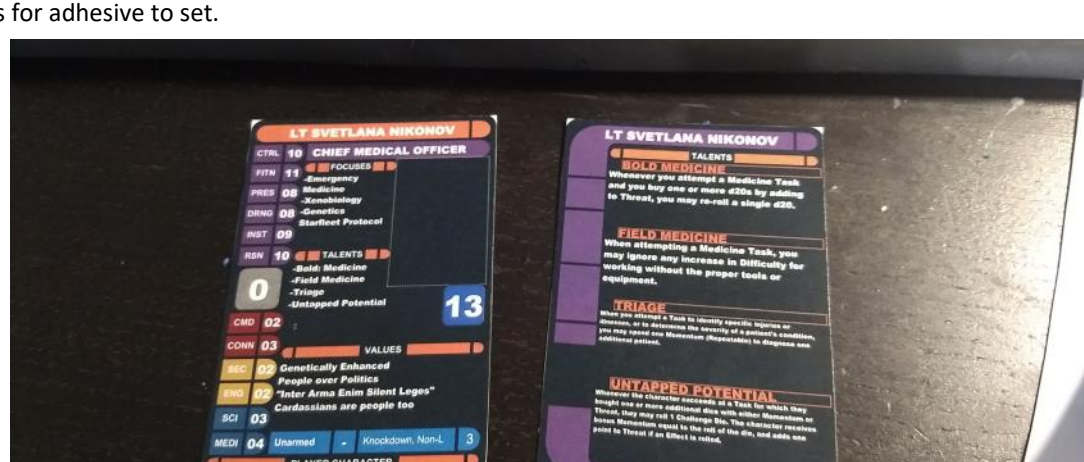
3) Fold and crease along the newly scored line. Make sure that when folded, the corners of the sheet line up on both sides.



4) Apply adhesive to back side, then fold sheet. Use your hand to rub out any air bubbles.



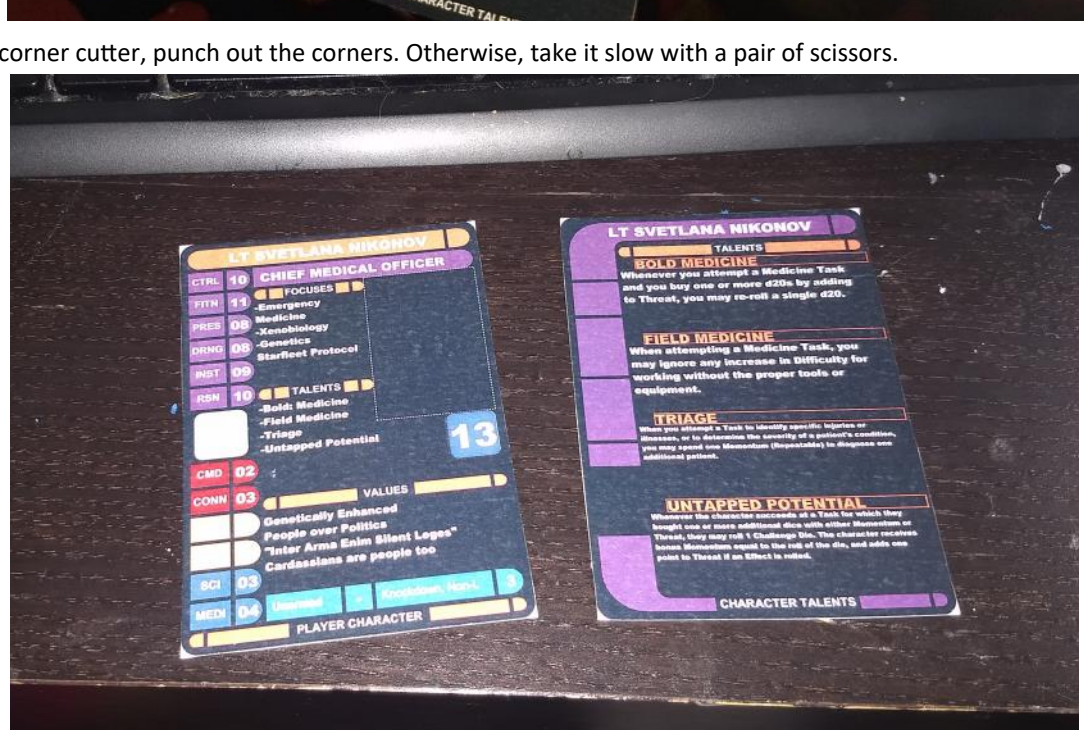
5) Place folded sheet inside a large book, like your outdated Star Trek RPG books. Weigh it down with weight, then wait at least 30 minutes for adhesive to set.



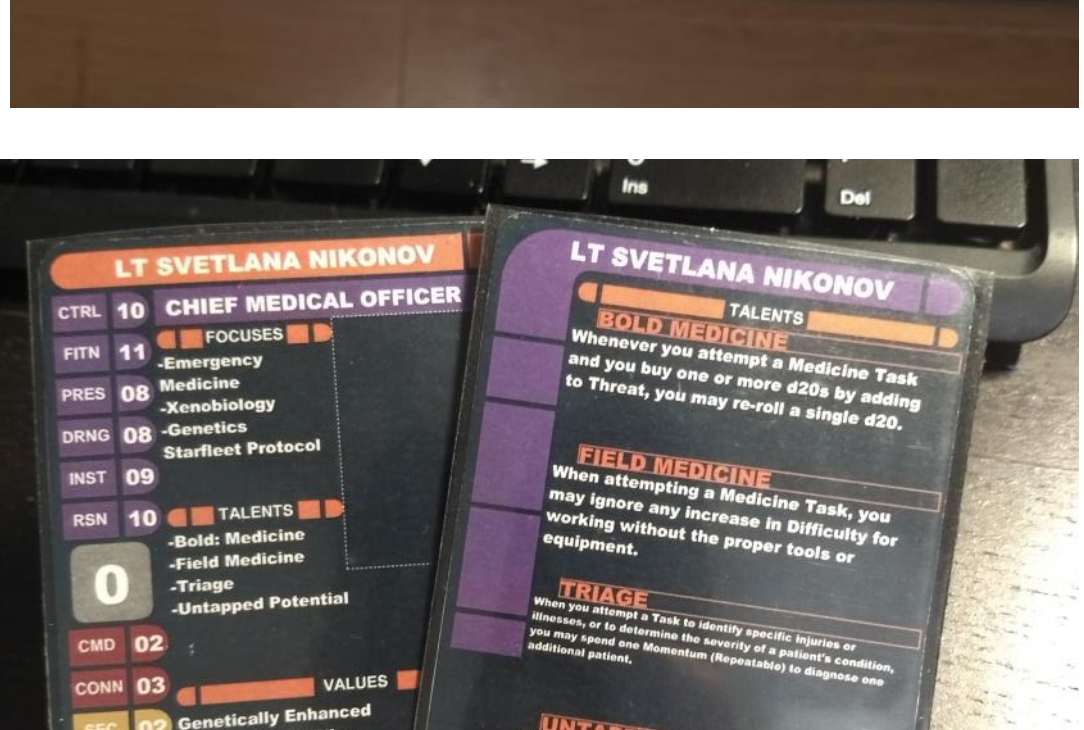
6) Cut out the cards from the sheet using your scissors. It pays to take your time during this step.



7) If you have a corner cutter, punch out the corners. Otherwise, take it slow with a pair of scissors.



8) Done.



Cards can be sleeved for additional protection.
