

MALACHOWSKI-CLASS LIGHT CRUISER

Entered Service 2220: *Malachowski*-class ships were retired from service in the late 2360s.



Overview: The compact, sleek-looking design of the *Malachowski* class was intended to be the future of the Federation when it was launched. Its engine design and fine-tuned sensors made it ideal for sending on round-trip missions to interesting systems in Starfleet's effort to continually push the boundaries of the Federation's maps. To the dismay of the *Malachowski* engineering team, however, barely three years after the design's launch Starfleet announced a turn to long-term, five-year missions. Smaller designs like the *Malachowski* were shelved in favor of more robust designs like the celebrated *Constitution* class. A number of *Malachowski*-class vessels were produced, however, and the design proved impressive enough that it remained in service well into the 24th century with the equally well-respected *Miranda* and *Centaur* classes. Eventually the *Malachowski* class was replaced by similar, more modern designs like the *Steamrunner* and *Norway* classes.

Capabilities: Smaller than other ship designs launched in the early 23rd century, the *Malachowski*-class starship makes up for this with speed and adaptability. During the war with the Klingons, many *Malachowski*-class vessels were sent to patrol the border and scan for enemy movement, a scouting role which led to a great deal of customization by chief engineers. Following peace between the Klingon Empire and the Federation, these customization details were formalized into the first of many refit plans to continuously improve the *Malachowski* design.
