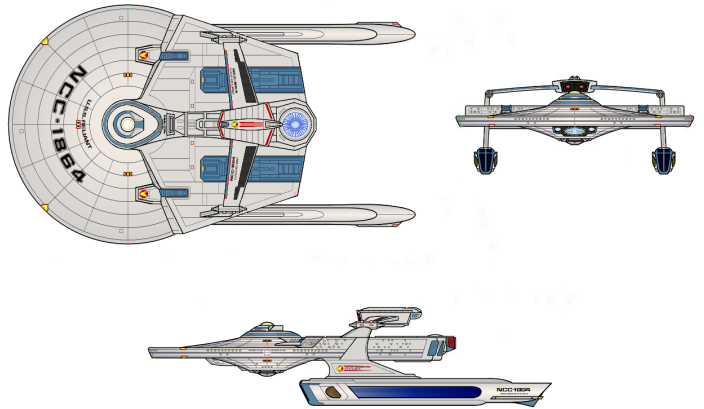

#### TALENTS:

- **Extensive Shuttlebays:** The ship may have twice as many small craft active at any one time as it would normally allow, and it may carry up to two Scale 2 small craft.
- **Fast Targeting Systems:** The ship does not suffer the normal Difficulty increase for targeting a specific System on an enemy ship.
- **Improved Impulse Drive:** When the flight controller succeeds at the *Impulse*, *Attack Pattern*, *Evasive Action*, or *Ramming Speed* Tasks, they may spend 2 Momentum to increase the Difficulty of attacks against the ship by 1 until the start of the flight controller's next Turn, due to the ship's rapid acceleration.
- **Rapid-Fire Torpedo Launcher:** Whenever the crew add 3 to Threat to fire a torpedo salvo, they may re-roll a single d20 on the attack, and any number of ▲ on the damage roll.
